



Home-School Agreement

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We wish to create a culture of learning, where children are happy, enthusiastic, motivated and ambitious.

We encourage mutual respect, support and collaboration between all adults and children, both within the school and the wider community.

We believe that it is important to provide a secure, caring and stimulating environment for all our children, promoting a sense of pride in our school.

This can be done most effectively when all staff, parents and children understand their responsibilities and work together towards the same goals, as detailed in this home/school agreement.

Working in Partnership for Success

The school will:

- Ensure your child's physical and social well being at all times, and to foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging.
- Deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child.
- To actively welcome parents/carers into the life of the school and to ensure that teaching staff are always available, by mutual arrangement, to discuss any concerns you might have about your child's progress or general welfare.
- Endeavour to meet the requirements of children whatever their needs to achieve their full potential.
- Ensure that each classroom is a positive and stimulating learning environment.
- Teach children to develop a positive attitude towards everyone regardless of difference in gender, race, culture, belief, values, age, and need.
- Help children to understand their role in the larger community.
- Communicate effectively and sensitively with parents.
- Provide prompt information and regular meetings to discuss:-
 - the progress of children, indicating strengths and areas for development through individual targets.
 - behaviour or class work that may be a cause for concern or celebration.
- Make available all relevant school policies, for information.

Parents/Carers

I/We undertake to:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and that absences are properly notified.
- Ensure that my child arrives and where appropriate is collected promptly at the beginning and end of the school day.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour and equal opportunities.
- Support my child in his/her homework.
- Ensure that my child goes to bed at a reasonable time on weekdays.
- Attend Parent's Evenings and discussions about my child's progress at school.

- Work in partnership with the school to develop positive attitudes towards those from different cultures and races and with different feelings, values and beliefs.
- Let the school know of any concerns that may affect their children's work or behaviour at school or ability to do homework.
- Foster a positive attitude towards education and the school and use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children, as these may have a negative effect on their outlook
- Make sure children wear suitable clothing for PE/games and kit is available in school each week.
- Ensure that children wear the agreed School Uniform

The child will:

- Understand that within the school every child has the right:
 - To be treated kindly; To be listened to;
 - To be helped; Not to be bullied; Not to be lonely;
 - To play and join in games; To be happy;
 - To feel wanted; To be safe; To be special.
- Respect others and their culture, race, feelings, beliefs and values.
- Accept responsibility for the things they do. Take responsibility for school and home work and to ask for help and to do their best in all they undertake.
 - Be kind and speak politely to everyone in school.
 - Take good care of the building, equipment and school grounds.
 - Behave in a safe way.
 - Be helpful.
 - Tell a member of staff if they are worried or unhappy.
- Ensure that they will take home all school letters.
