Dear Parents,

Just a note about the final arrangements for next week!

**Foundation Phase Concerts are on Tuesday and Wednesday (6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>) in school.** Children should be in school by 5.30 so they can change and be ready on time. Please bring the children in to the school and send them down to their class. The performance will start at 6pm and we expect children to be collected at 7pm. Children will be released back to parents as they are at the end of the day direct from the door by their classroom. Parents **will not** be permitted to park on the school yard on safety grounds.

**Key Stage 2 Concert will be in Penglais School at 6pm on Thursday (8<sup>th</sup>).** We ask for the children who are playing musical instruments or wearing costume to be there by 5.30pm and all others by 5.45pm. Having felt how warm it got today in practice we ask if every child could be dressed in a **clean yellow school polo shirt** for the concert. We also ask if they could wear dark coloured trousers or leggings and suitable dark footwear. Please don't send children in shoes that light up or flash. If you haven't enough uniform please ask your child's teacher who can loan some. Parents should keep hold of jumpers and coats to avoid confusion at the end!

At the end of the performance we will release children to their parents. We would appreciate your help in remaining seated until it is your child's class which is called and then leaving the hall as quickly as possible to ensure children reach their families safely.

In the interest of privacy and safety we ask for your help with the following:-

- As there are children in school who cannot have their photographs taken there will be no cameras or telephones allowed to be used during the concerts. Photographs will be made available on the school website.
- Parents are not permitted to walk around the schools or in to classrooms. Please use the toilets nearest to the hall.
- Please, please take great care with the children in the car park areas in the dark and, possibly, wet conditions. We ask for your help with this as accidents can happen so easily. Please take particular care and also give consideration to our neighbours who need access to their drives.

The PTA request that all raffle tickets sold or unsold be returned to school as soon as possible. There are numerous prizes as listed below: £50, Hamper donated by Comins Coch staff, meal for 2 at the Starling Cloud, Fantasy Farm Family pass, £20 Medina voucher and lots of other prizes.

Don't forget the PTA Social Evening tonight at the Glengower from 7.30pm. Look out for the red balloon!

Also, don't forget our Christmas Bingo evening on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December @ 5.00pm – a fun event for parents and children to get into the spirit of Christmas.

I would also like to inform you that we will be holding a 'Christmas Jumper' day on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December. Children are welcome to wear their Christmas jumpers and make a donation towards an international charity of the School / Eco councils' choice.
